Credicorp Flex report: hospitality weekend stock cycles

A report for hospitality companies buying stock before the weekend takings arrive.

Hospitality venues buy food, drink and rota cover before the peak trading days pay back. The decision is easier when the company writes down the invoice, the date and the repayment source.

Credicorp Flex can fit repeated short stock cycles where card takings repay the draw quickly. A clean use case has a specific cost, a specific business purpose and a specific repayment source.

Wastage and quiet weekends matter. Base drawings on conservative sales, not best weekends. The sources below show the rule, product page or public register behind the point.

For Credicorp Flex, the discipline is to draw for short needs and repay when receipts land, not to treat the limit as extra revenue.
