Credicorp Flex report: marketplace payout delays

A note for ecommerce companies whose platform payouts lag stock and fulfilment costs.

Marketplace sellers can ship goods days or weeks before the platform releases funds. A director should separate timing pressure from a weaker margin before choosing any finance route.

Credicorp Flex can fit where the payout lag repeats and the company has clean sales evidence. The product fit comes from the shape of the cost, not from the page label.

Platform reserves and disputes can change expected cash. Do not draw against uncertain payouts. Recheck the linked product and public-source pages before relying on the note.

For Credicorp Flex, the discipline is to draw for short needs and repay when receipts land, not to treat the limit as extra revenue.
