# Credicorp Slice report: training course invoice

How to decide whether a training invoice is worth spreading across instalments.

Training may be needed for compliance, safety or a new contract before cash is comfortable. A director should separate timing pressure from a weaker margin before choosing any finance route.

Credicorp Slice can fit a course invoice where the company can name the business reason. The product fit comes from the shape of the cost, not from the page label.

Avoid vague skills spend. Tie the course to compliance, revenue, capacity or a contract. Recheck the linked product and public-source pages before relying on the note.

For Credicorp Slice, start with the supplier invoice. If there is no defined bill to spread, it is probably the wrong route.
