Credicorp product comparison: Asset Purchases checklist

A sourced checklist for comparing Credicorp Loan, Credicorp Flex and Credicorp Slice when asset purchases affects cash flow.

Asset purchases can improve capacity, but they also tie cash to one item. A director should separate timing pressure from a weaker margin before choosing any finance route.

Use the product comparison route when the company is still choosing between a fixed loan, a revolving facility and splitting one invoice. The product fit comes from the shape of the cost, not from the page label.

Compare repair, hire, asset finance and short-term borrowing before choosing the fastest option. Recheck the linked product and public-source pages before relying on the note.

For the product comparison route, decide what shape the pressure has first: one dated gap, repeated draw-and-repay pressure, or one invoice to split.
